All Sunday School Students

All Sunday school students are expected to:

Preschool/Kindergarten

In addition to the above, students finishing the **Kindergarten** level are expected to recite/sing together with their classmates:

- ✓ Simple **Bible passages** by heart.
- ✓ Each of the **Ten Commandments** by heart.
- ✓ Each petition of the **Lord's Prayer** by heart.
- ✓ Each line of the **Apostles' Creed** by heart.
- ✓ Simple **hymns, canticles, and children's songs** by heart.
- ✓ The **Common Table Prayer** by heart.

First/Second Grade

In addition to the above, students finishing the **Second Grade** are expected to recite/sing together with their classmates:

- ✓ Additional **Bible passages** by heart.
- ✓ **The Ten Commandments, The Creed, and The Lord's Prayer** by heart.
- ✓ Luther's **Morning Prayer and Evening Prayer** by heart.
- ✓ Additional **hymns, canticles, and children's songs**.

Third/Fourth Grade

In addition to the above, students finishing the **Fourth Grade** are expected to recite by themselves and/or sing with their classmates:

- ✓ Advanced **Bible passages** by heart.
- ✓ **The Ten Commandments, The Creed, and The Lord's Prayer** (with meanings) by heart.
- ✓ **Asking a Blessing** by heart.
- ✓ Additional **hymns, canticles, and children's songs**.

Fifth/Sixth Grade

In addition to the above, students finishing the **Sixth Grade** are expected to recite by themselves and/or sing with their classmates:

- ✓ More advanced **Bible passages** by heart.
- ✓ **The Sacrament of Holy Baptism, Confession, and The Sacrament of the Altar** by heart.
- ✓ The **Books of the Old Testament and Books of the New Testament** by heart.
- ✓ Additional **hymns, canticles, and children's songs**.
